STRUCTURE OF THE ARTICLE

Please follow the structure provided!

- Title of the paper** (all caps, centered, **bold**, 14 pt)
- Author's name, surname** (all caps, centered, **bold**, *italic*, 12 pt)
- Name of the college, school or university** (centered, normal, 12 pt)
- Supervisor/Consultant** (centered, normal, 12 pt)
- Annotation** (text up to 1000 characters, *italic*, 11 pt)
- Introduction, chapter titles and conclusions** (**bold**, normal, 12 pt, and alignment left with 1 cm indentation)
- Text** (see Layout requirements).
- Tables** (title (centered, **bold**, 10 pt), should be above the table; Arabic numbering should be used; table data with normal, 10 pt).
- Pictures** (title (centered, **bold**, 10 pt), should be under the picture).
- Formulas** (have to be formatted with equation editor of MS Word, 10 pt)
- References and literature list** have to be formatted using APA (American Psychology Association) citation standard; (title **bold**, text normal, 11 p)

REQUIREMENTS FOR ARTICLES

The article should not exceed 5 – 10 pages and should be written in A4 format.

Articles will be reviewed. In case of critical remarks, conference participants will have to make corrections of their articles by 19 November 2021.
